

## Regulations for the Application of the Shen-Non Prize

<b>Purpose</b>	To encourage students to participate in research and foster students' research abilities
<b>Eligibility</b>	All students in the National Sun Yat-sen University Department of Biological Sciences
<b>Date</b>	School Anniversary
<b>Venue</b>	Biological Sciences Building
<b>Method</b>	Undergraduate and graduate students are grouped and evaluated (A, B, C). 1. Research results shall be displayed in poster form. Physical samples may also be displayed. 2. Faculty members from other departments are invited by the Department's Academic Committee to serve on the review committee. 3. During the review period, participants are required to provide in-situ explanations. 4. Evaluation standard: Content (60%), Theme and Creativity (10%), Experiment Design (10%), Art Production (10%), Data Analysis and Future Research Potential (10%)

<b>Prizes</b>	Undergraduate and graduate students are grouped and evaluated (A, B, C). 1. Scholarships and awards are provided to students as incentives to enhance research practices. Excellence: NT\$5,000 scholarship and a certificate Outstanding Performance: NT \$3,000 scholarship and a certificate Runner-Up: NT\$2,000 scholarship and a certificate Honorable Mention: NT\$1,000 scholarship and a certificate 2. Each category is awarded to one student, with the exception of the Honorable Mention Award, which may be awarded to a maximum of two students.
<b>Funds and Grants</b>	Each participant may claim a maximum of NT\$800 as reimbursement for poster production.
<b>Notes</b>	The present regulations shall be implemented once approved in the Department Affairs Meeting. The same provisions apply to the revision of the directions.
